**Eligible Rifles:** As Issued M1 Garand, CMP rule 6.2.4 applies

**Safety:** Eye & Ear protection required, ECI's mandatory.

**Match Fee:** \$25.00, lunch included.

**CMP LC Ammo Available:** \$15.00 / 60 rounds.

**Course of Fire:** Garand Match B, 100 yards and SR-1 targets.  
50 rounds for score plus up to 5 sighters.

**Slow Prone:** 5 sighters maximum with 20 rounds for score in 25 minutes.

**Rapid Prone from Standing:** 10 rounds in 70 seconds, reload required.

**Rapid Sitting from Standing:** 10 rounds in 60 seconds, reload required.

**Offhand ( Standing):** 10 rounds in ten minutes.

Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place based on a total aggregate score. Competitors using other service rifles are welcome to shoot while not being eligible for awards.

**The Cause:** M1's for Vets was started by John O'Shea of the Lake Norman High Power Club near Huntersville, NC. November 2005 with a single rifle presented to a wounded Marine veteran of the War on Terror.
