Rules: CMP Competition Rifle Rules Apply

Rifle: As issued M1 Garand, M1903 M1903-A3, M1917, M1941 and Vintage Foreign Rifles as defined in CMP rules may be used. M1-A and AR-15 rifles may be used, but are not eligible for CMP awards. Separate awards will be given for these two categories.

Awards: 1st, 2nd and 3rd (gold, silver and bronze) CMP pins for each category eligible for awards Garand, Springfield and Vintage Military.

Fee: The match fee is \$20.00.. All of the net proceeds will be donated directly to the **M-1 for Vets** program. Additional relays are encouraged and may be shot for \$ 10.00 per relay. When you pre-register, please indicate how many relays you are going to shoot. We can accommodate 20 shooters per relay.

Registration: Advance registration is required to assign relay times. You may register the day of the match, but a specific relay time cannot be guaranteed.
