RELAYS/FIRING POINTS: **FOUR RELAYS/20 FIRING POINTS.**

MATCH RULES: **CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM RIM FIRE SPORTER Rules govern this match.**

**OPEN TO: All shooters, 14 years or older. Minors must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Sporter type 22 caliber rimfire rifles or carbines are allowed. Open class and Target class (target sights and scopes) will be scored separately.**

COURSE OF FIRE: CMP Rimfire Sporter target (NLU10512RF) 50 ft prone & sitting.  
CMP Rimfire Sporter target (1321RF) 50 ft standing.

- **Unlimited sight-in shots any position. A rest may be used, 10 minutes.**
- **Slow fire prone: 10 shots/10 minutes, prone.**
- **Rapid fire prone: 10 shots (2-series of 5 rounds) 25 Seconds for semi-auto & 30 seconds for manual (Bolt or Lever).**
- **Slow fire: Sitting or Kneeling (Your choice) 10 shots in 10 minutes.**
- **Rapid fire from Sitting or Kneeling: 10 shots (2 set of 5 rounds) in 25 Seconds for semi-auto & 30 seconds for manual.**
- **Slow fire: Offhand (standing) 10 shots in 10 minutes.**
- **Rapid Fire: Offhand (Standing) 10 shots (2 sets of 5 rounds) in 25 Seconds for semi-auto & 30 seconds for manual.**

**RIFLES:** CMP Rimfire Sporter rules apply, see [www.odcmp.com](http://www.odcmp.com) to download Rimfire Sporter rulebook. Rifle cannot weigh more than 7.5 pounds. Trigger must be capable of lifting a three pound weight.

**AMMUNITION:** Shooters may use any .22 cal long rifle ammunition they wish. Shooters must be sure to select ammunition that not only shoots accurately, but that functions reliably when fed from a magazine during rapid fire since there are no alibis or refires for malfunctions in the Rimfire Sporter.

**LOANER RIFLES:** Available for registered shooters.

**BEVERAGES:** No alcohol permitted on the club premises. Soda and bottled water will be available for purchase.

FEES: Make Checks payable to "Dave Dieball"

- Adults: \$10 includes CMP Scorecard, 6 targets and 100 rounds of ammunition.
- Ages 14-18 years: \$5 includes CMP Scorecard, 6 targets and 100 rounds of ammunition.

NOTE:

- An eligibility affidavit and liability waiver must be signed during registration.

NUMBER OF RELAYS/FIRING POINTS: 5 relays /10 firing points (40 round M1 Carbine Match relay 5 only)

RULES: CMP Rules 6.2.4, 6.2.5, 9.1.3, 9.2.1 & 9.3.1 govern this match.

OPEN TO: 14 years of age or older. Minors must be accompanied by responsible adult.

COURSE OF FIRE: NRA SR-1 100 yard targets

- Slow fire: Prone 15 shots/15 minutes, (includes five sighter shots).
- Rapid fire: Prone from Standing: 10 shots in 70 seconds (80 seconds for Bolt-Action), 100 yards.
- Slow fire: Offhand (standing) 10 shots in 10 minutes.
- M1 Carbine Only: Rapid Prone from standing: 10 shots in 70 seconds with two 5-round magazines.

**RIFLES:** Open to CMP Military Service Issue rifles according to CMP Rules with iron sights; M1903, M1903A1, M1903A3, M1917, Vintage Military Bolt-action Rifles (as issued), M1 Carbine (relay 5 only).

**AMMUNITION:** Forty rounds ammo issued for Caliber 30-06 only. Vintage & M1 Carbine rifles shooters bring ammo.

**LOANER RIFLES:** Some loaner rifles will be available.

**FOOD & BEVERAGES:** No alcohol permitted on the club premises. Food, sodas and bottled water will be available for purchase from the clubhouse.

**FEES:** Make Checks payable to “Dave Dieball” (PROFITS WILL BENEFIT THE “M1 FOR VETS” PROGRAM)

- Adults: \$30 includes 40 rounds 30-06 ball ammo. Profit goes towards the “M1 for Vets” program.
- Vintage Military Bolt Action: \$20 (Bring your ammo)
- Second entry \$10, does not include ammunition.
