

Known as the home of marksmanship, Camp Perry continues to serve thousands of shooters, the military and their families.

Friends of Camp Perry is embarking on a fund raising program permitting active and former military personnel, visitors, and private citizens to purchase memorial bricks in the *Shooters Memorial Plaza* around the *Oliver Hazard Perry Monument*. These lasting memorials are high-quality paver bricks with names or messages professionally sandblasted up to three lines per brick, with up to fourteen characters per line.

The money raised by the Brick program will be used by *Friends of Camp Perry* to offset plaza costs and fund additional programs for service personnel stationed at Camp Perry and their families.

CAMP PERRY

If you're a shooter or a supporter of our Military, you are probably familiar with historic Camp Perry. Established in 1906 and located on Lake Erie near Port Clinton, Ohio, Camp Perry has been home to the National Pistol and Rifle Matches since 1907 drawing thousands of competitors each year.

Camp Perry serves local and federal law enforcement, Homeland Security and various angencies of the Department of Defense.

HISTORY

Camp Perry was named after Commodore Oliver Hazard Perry, the victorious American Commander who defeated the British in 1813 at the Battle of Lake Erie.


Evolving into a permanent military installation, Camp Perry has the largest and best equipped rifle and pistol ranges in the United States, if not the world.

Camp Perry played vital roles in federal service. In World War I it was used as a training center for officers and marksmanship instructors.

During World War II, Camp Perry also served as a reception center for new recruits and as a POW camp for German and Italian prisoners of war. The *Friends of Camp Perry* is a group of men and women who volunteer their time providing support to Camp Perry. Their mission is "to promote the health and welfare of soliders, sailors, and their families stationed here and to preserve the heritage, history, and traditions of

Camp Perry."
